Dunollie Wood Welcome to Scotland's Rainforest!

Scotland's Rainforest is one of our most precious habitats - as important as tropical rainforest, but rarer.

Also known as Atlantic woodland, Scotland's west coast has some of the best remaining rainforest in Europe thanks to a combination of high rainfall and mild, year-round temperatures. Rainforest sites like Dunollie provide a refuge for some of the world's rarest bryophytes and lichens, with over 200 species found in this wood alone. It is the diversity of rare bryophytes and lichens that make Scotland's rainforest internationally important. Besides maintaining humidity, thick carpets of dripping mosses, layering liverworts, epiphytic ferns and colourful fungi like the rare hazel gloves fungus, give the rainforest a unique and magical feel.
