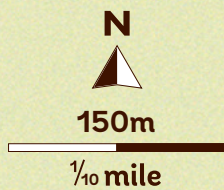





Welcome to Harpsden and Peveril Woods

This 19 hectare (46 acre) ancient woodland within the Chiltern Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty is home to beech, oak and ash. You'll also see a variety of other trees, including hazel, field maple and wild cherry.

A public bridleway and a network of permissive paths provide for a variety of circular walks. A public footpath crosses Woodlands Road.

Please keep to the main paths to avoid encroaching on the delicate woodland floor.

Paths are unsurfaced and muddy in winter. There are some steep slopes towards the north of the site. The rest of the wood is reasonably flat.
