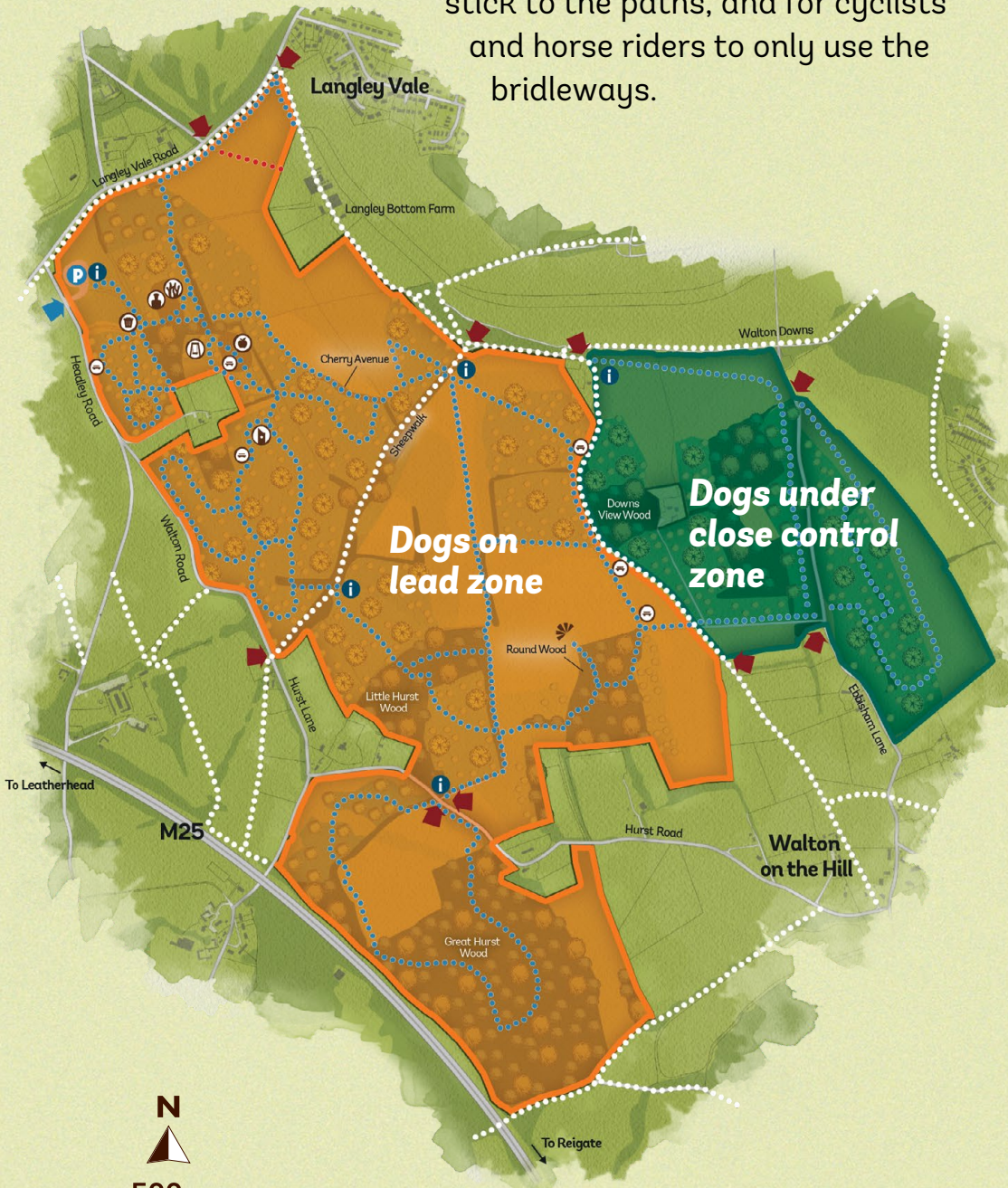


# Walkies in Langley Vale Wood
