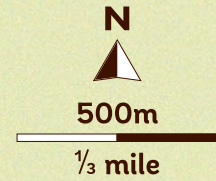


Welcome to Langley Vale Wood

Downs View Trail
 2½ miles (4.5km) | Moderate

Some smooth, wide paths with uneven sections which can be muddy after rain or in the winter months. Several steep slopes. Various access gates along this route.

Remembrance Way
 2 miles / 3.1km | Easy

Mostly wide, smooth, and grassy path. Includes some gates which can be diverted. One slight incline.
