

Londonthorpe Woods and Bellmount



●●● Tower Trail 1.9 miles/3km | Moderate | Allow 1 hour

A circular route through 100 year old woodland and areas of open grassland. Discover Bellmount Tower with its panoramic views over Belton House and the surrounding countryside.

Some sections with steep and moderate slopes. Mostly grass or earth paths that are uneven in places and can be muddy after rain. Includes a bridge and multiple gates.

●●● Londonthorpe Loop 0.9 miles/1.4km | Easy | Allow 30 minutes

An easy circular route that meanders through open grassland and areas of woodland.

Wide and flat with smooth, firm surface. No gates or steps.

●●● Alma Ramble 2.4 miles/4km | Moderate | Allow 1hr 30 minutes

A circular route around Alma Wood and Alma Park. A varied walk through old and new woodland, ecologically valuable scrubland and open grassland. There are multiple shortcut options too.

Some sections with moderate slopes. Mostly grass paths that are uneven in places and can be muddy after rain. Includes kissing gates and cattle may be present in some areas, although diversions are sign posted.
